How to Renew for 2012

Simply follow these quick, easy steps to renew online:

1. Visit www.oand.org and log in to the Members Only section using your existing login name and password included in the cover letter to this package.
2. Click on the link: "My Account"
3. Click on the link: "Renew your membership online for 2012"
4. Review your 2012 Membership Category and Dues and complete the form
5. You will now see a summary of your membership dues owing for 2012
6. Click on the "Add Selected Items to Cart" button to follow the secure check-out process to pay your dues to complete your membership renewal.
7. Your membership is now renewed for 2012 – congratulations!

2. Sign the enclosed OAND Membership Contract, including your fee category and payment plan selection and Membership Special Status Declaration Form, if applicable.
- Sign up for the Auto-Renewal Plan and save up to \$60 per year.
- Send the OAND Membership Contract with payment to the OAND at the address at the bottom of this page.

The above fee schedule includes 13% HST and a monthly payment administration fee, where applicable. The membership year is January 1st to December 31st annually. All memberships expire on December 31st, regardless of when they commenced.

Please Note: if we are unable to process your credit card application for any reason, or if your cheque payment is returned NSF, you will be charged a \$30.00 processing fee. Please keep us informed when your credit card details change including your expiry date. Thirty days written notice is required should you wish to cancel your membership. Non-payment of membership dues will result in termination of membership in the OAND.
