

COVID-19 Screening Questions for Patients

Naturopathic Doctors and all other regulated health practitioners are required by the Ontario Ministry of Health & Long-Term Care to screen every patient attending an in-person appointment.

If you answer “yes” to any of the following questions, we cannot see you for an in-person appointment and you must get tested for COVID-19.

1.
Have you travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days?



2.
Have you tested positive for COVID-19 or had close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 without wearing appropriate PPE?



3.
Do you have any of the following symptoms?

- Fever
- New onset of cough
- Worsening chronic cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Difficulty swallowing
- Decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell
- Chills
- Headaches
- Unexplained fatigue/malaise/muscle aches (myalgias)
- Nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
- Pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- Runny nose or nasal congestion without other known cause



4.
If you are 70 years of age or older, are you experiencing any of the following symptoms?

- Delirium
- Unexplained or increased number of falls
- Acute functional decline
- Worsening of chronic conditions

COVID-19 Screening Results

- If your responses to ALL of the screening questions is NO: You have screened “Negative” and may attend your appointment.
- If your response to ANY of the screening questions is YES: You have screened “Positive” should self-isolate and get tested.
